Please label each item brought to camp.

Davening:

1st through 4th Grade will daven in camp.

5th and 6th Grade: Please daven **before** camp.

Lunch: Please send lunch/snacks/drinks from home daily. Please note that we are a **nut free** facility. CRC WILL provide snacks on trip days.

Canteen: Snacks can be 'purchased' from the canteen with tickets only. Tickets are earned during learning group. No canteen purchases can be made with real money.

Night Activity Trips: These trips may incur an extra fee.

Please take note of the following camp rules:

1. **NO electronic devices** are allowed in camp besides for cameras. If found, they will be removed and returned after August 23rd.
2. **NO balls** are allowed inside Taylor Rd. Synagogue. Any balls brought to camp should be labeled and deposited in the storage box outside the building.
3. **NO gum** is allowed in camp
4. All means of transportation (bikes, scooters, delta wings, skateboards, etc. etc.) should be left OUTSIDE the building; locked up properly. Nothing can be left in camp other than a locked bike if necessary. Please note that CRC and TRS does not take responsibility for any stolen belongings

All camp fees must be paid by July 21. Checks can be mailed to 3642 Shannon Rd.

All items left in camp after August 23rd will be considered hefker.
